

"Barral Vascular Manipulation" with **Jeffrey Burch, L.M.T.**

Presentation: Studies conducted in France in the late 1970's demonstrated the prevalence of Nerve and Vascular injuries from impact injuries. French Osteopaths Jean-Pierre Barral and Alain Croibier worked with contractures and adhesions in nerves and blood vessels. This presentation will highlight these highly effective methods in treating chronic pain which has an impact injury history component.

Speaker: Jeffrey Burch, M.S., L.M.T. practices in Eugene and Portland, Oregon. He originally trained in Rolwing structural Integration graduating in 1977. Since then he has earned a Masters Degree in counseling and has received extensive training in Osteopathic soft tissue treatment methods. He teaches introductory craniosacral therapy courses for the Intentional Alliance of Health Care Educators, and continuing education courses for the Rolf Institute. He is trained to the instruction level in visceral manipulation. He has published articles on related topics and is currently writing a book on treatment methods. Most of his work is with chronic pain clients.
